



Directions to WVU Tech from Charleston, WV

If traveling from Beckley/Wytheville, take I-77N/I64E and follow directions.

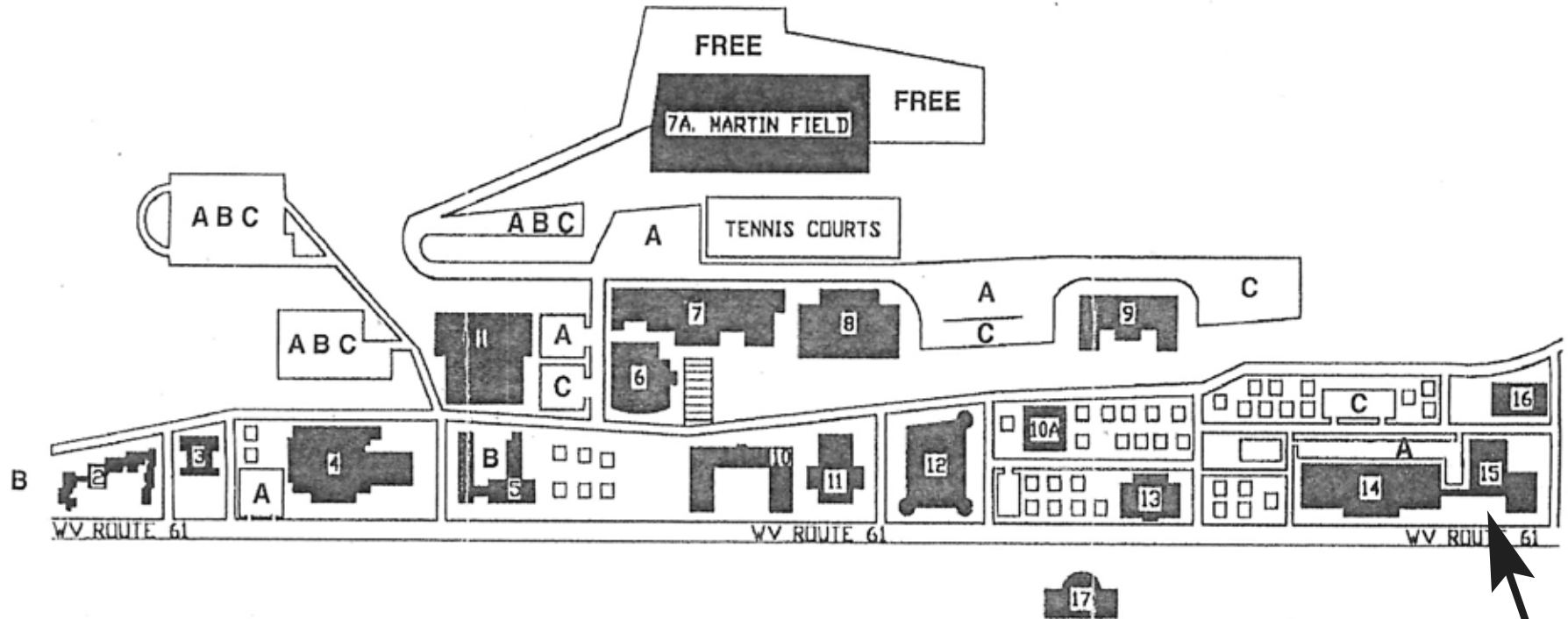
- Take I-77S/I-64E towards Beckley
- Take Exit 85 toward Chelyan/Cedar Grove.
- Drive up to traffic lights and go through them across the bridge.
- At end of bridge, turn right onto Route 60.
- Drive for about 20 minutes, going through several small vicinities.
- Take the Montgomery/WVU Tech exit on your right.
- Turn right at top of ramp and cross bridge. Do not get off on the downtown ramp, keep going straight and around a sharp curve to a stop sign.
- Turn left at the stop sign onto Route 61.
- Drive several blocks to the 4-way stop (there is only one).
- Go through the stop.
- You will pass the Engineering Lab Building on your left.
- The next building on your left is the Leonard C. Nelson College of Engineering Building.
- Park on the street and enter through front door of the Leonard C. Nelson College of Engineering Building. I will meet you there!
